An INHOPE snapshot – my experiences

- ✘ Network established in 1999 - 10 years old in Nov 2009
- ✘ Shares reports about Child Pornography on the Internet
- ✘ Member of the board including President to 2002
- ✘ CEO from Feb 2003 until Sep 2007
- ✘ INHOPE started with 10 hotlines and now has >32 hotlines in ~30 countries
- ✘ Funded by EC, Membership fees and industry support
- ✘ Develops best practice and codes of practice for operation of a hotline and shares knowledge
- ✘ Useful model and experiences for 2centre
